CYBERLEARNING ACADEMY COURSE INFORMATION



General Overview

- *The National Educational Foundation and the Jamestown Public School District have agreed to create a **CYBERLEARNING ACADEMY** to offer teachers and students the opportunity to access and utilize numerous internet based courses at no charge. There are nearly 100 **DIFFERENT COURSES IN SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY, MATHEMATICS, BUSINESS, AND UNITED STATES HISTORY AND GOVERNMENT.***
- *These “Cyberlearning Courses” are primarily designed to supplement and reinforce the topics presented by teachers in the classroom. EACH PARTICIPATING TEACHER WILL ADVISE STUDENTS IF THEY ARE ENROLLED IN A CYBERLEARNING COURSE PACKAGE.*
- *ALL JAMESTOWN HIGH SCHOOL JUNIORS AND SENIORS HAVE BEEN ENROLLED IN THE: BARRON’S SAT REVIEW PACKAGE-- “HOW TO PREPARE FOR THE NEW SAT”: This course is designed as a “**SELF DIRECTED COURSE**” so students can study on their own and focus on the topics needing improvement including: critical reading, writing and mathematical questions, testing tactics, model tests to enhance your experience, comprehensive mathematics review, and basic/frequency word lists.*

- **THESE COURSES ARE INTERNET BASED AND REQUIRE THE FOLLOWING:**
- Computers must have access to the Internet.
- Courses were designed to operate on Windows based-computers and need Windows 2000, XP, Vista, or 7—however, almost all courses will run on Apple Computers with Mac OS X v10.4 and later.
- The browser should support flash player version 8.0 or above.
- Adobe Acrobat Reader version 6.0 or above should be installed
- If you have a pop-up blocking software on your computers, you should disable or with Windows, press Ctrl when opening topics and exercises in a new window.

HOW TO ACCESS

1. Go to <http://lms.cyberlearning.org/>
2. In the upper RIGHT corner, Click on “Login” and you will see:

3. Type in User Name and Password (cookies must be enabled in your browser)

- **USER NAME IS YOUR STUDENT ID NUMBER**
- **PASSWORD IS THE SAME PASSWORD YOU USE TO ACCESS SCHOOL COMPUTERS**

4. When the Login is successful, you will see YOUR NAME in the Upper Right Corner:



You are logged in as YOUR NAME (Logout)

IF YOU HAVE A PROBLEM WITH LOGIN:

- **BE SURE YOUR TEACHER HAS TOLD YOU THAT YOU ARE ENROLLED IN A SPECIFIC COURSE PACKAGE.**
- **REMEMBER ALL JUNIORS AND SENIORS ARE ENROLLED IN THE *BARRON'S SAT REVIEW PACKAGE.***
- **SEND AN EMAIL TO THE JAMESTOWN ACADEMY DIRECTOR INCLUDING:**

5. Upon Successful Login-- In the center of the screen you will see:

- **My Group: The Name of Your School**
- **My Packages: The Courses You May Access**
